<b>1 Simple</b>	Limited	<p>Clear terrain with runout zones of infrequent avalanches.</p> <p>Exposure to avalanche terrain easy to avoid or eliminate.</p> <p><i>The terrain needs to be handled as challenging in poor visibility.</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Being able to use the avalanche forecast</li> <li>• Perform avalanche self rescue</li> <li>• Recognize avalanche terrain</li> <li>• General skills with outdoor life during winter</li> </ul>
<b>2 Challenging</b>	Frequent	<p>Terrain with well defined start zones, runout zones and terrain traps.</p> <p>Exposure to avalanche terrain can be reduced or eliminated with careful route finding.</p> <p><i>The terrain needs to be handled as complex in poor visibility.</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Make active route findings based on the terrain and avalanche problem</li> <li>• Being able to use the avalanche forecast</li> <li>• Consider snow stability in a slope</li> <li>• Important with good navigation skills</li> <li>• Perform avalanche self rescue</li> <li>• Recognize avalanche terrain</li> <li>• General skills with outdoor life during winter</li> </ul>
<b>3 Complex</b>	Continual	<p>Unclear, steep terrain with several starts zones, runout zones and many terrain traps.</p> <p>Exposure to avalanche terrain not possible to reduce or avoid.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Continuously evaluating the snow stability</li> <li>• Make active route findings based on the terrain and avalanche problem</li> <li>• Essential with good navigation skills</li> <li>• Being able to use the avalanche forecast</li> <li>• Perform avalanche self rescue</li> <li>• Recognize avalanche terrain</li> <li>• General skills with outdoor life during winter</li> </ul>
